FOR 38 YEARS, A JOYOUS EXPERIENCE IN CHRISTIAN EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY THROUGH MUSIC

The West Side Presbyterian Church 38th Annual Summer Choir School will be held August 23-27, 2010, 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. daily at West Side Presbyterian Church, Six South Monroe Street, Ridgewood. The program is open to all children who will have completed grades **two** through **eight**, regardless of church affiliation.

An excellent staff, some of whom were once Summer Choir School choristers themselves, will lead the program under the direction of Joanne Harris Rodland, Minister of Music at West Side Church, and Deborah Holden-Holloway, Associate Minister of Music at West Side Church. All students must be present for the closing service, given for the public on Friday evening, August 27, at 7:30 p.m., at West Side Presbyterian Church.

Choir School is designed for singers who find joy in praising God through music. Each child participates in a small choir rehearsal and two all-school rehearsals daily. Bible study, varied worship experiences, and an elective activity complete the morning schedule. Singing, playing, and studying together, the children and adults form a community whose bonds endure long past the summer. They also develop skills which will help them as they continue to serve God through music during the year.

"Journey of the Spirit" is our 2010 Summer Choir School curriculum theme. Supported by hymns, anthems and speech chants, Bible study classes will explore the story of the church from its roots in the faith of our Jewish brothers and sisters, through the growth of the early church, the medieval church, and the church of the Reformation. The final day will look into the church of the future as an outgrowth of our past.

Registration Information

Approval Required: Applications must be approved by a choir director or private music instructor.

Elective choices will be determined by the date on which the application with payment is received.

Deadline: Deadline for registration is August 1, 2010. Registration will automatically be cut off if maximum enrollment is reached before that date.

Cost: The registration is \$60 for the first child, \$50 for each additional child in a family. **A check for full payment must accompany the registration application.** Make your check payable to West Side Presbyterian Church, with "Summer Choir School" on the memo line.

Special Needs: If your child has special needs or allergies, please let us know.

Sports and Games (limit 15 participants)

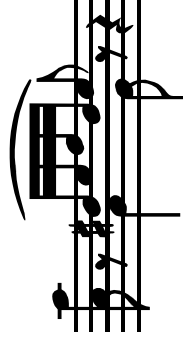
